HOW TO READ THIS CHART

Each horizontal line represents a string and each vertical line represents a fret. The thicker vertical line on the left represents the guitar nut that sits below the headstock.



FIND NOTES

Locate any note on any fret. Unmarked frets are sharps (#) and flats (b). A sharp is the note before it raised by one fret and a flat is the note after it lowered by one fret.



BUILD CHORDS

Find the root note of any chord and build the chord shape from there.



LEARN SCALES

Identify scale patterns and learn the notes within them.
